

# DESIGNATED DESIGN-BUILD PROFESSIONAL™ CERTIFICATION RENEWAL INFORMATION



## CERTIFICATION RENEWAL GUIDELINES, APPLICABLE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

Certified individuals are required to report 24 hours of approved continuing education credit every two years. Reported hours must be received by December 31 in the year in which your renewal is due (e.g. whether you received your certification in June 2015 or November 2015, your renewal is due on December 31, 2017).

Below is an overview of the types of programs/activities acceptable to meet the DBIA™ and Assoc. DBIA™ continuing education requirement. This list is not all-inclusive. Other programs may qualify if they are deemed by the Design-Build Certification Board to provide direct value to your success as a design-build professional.
