



DBIA 2018 TRANSPORTATION OWNER OF THE YEAR APPLICATION

DBIA's Transportation Owner of the Year Awards pay tribute to owner organizations in the transportation industry that have made significant contributions in advancing the awareness, understanding and use of the design-build project delivery method.

The award will be presented at the 2018 Design-Build in Transportation Conference held March 21-23 in Portland, Oregon.

Nominated organizations may come from any transportation sector including, but not limited to, highways/bridges, marine/water, rail and air. Nominations should address leadership in the areas of technical, legislative, organizational, industry-wide or agency-wide actions as well as support for DBIA's Industry Best Practices.

Applications are being accepted through **January 26, 2018**.

Who is Eligible: Any owner organization in the transportation field, public or private, as long as they utilize design-build.

DBIA encourages owners who are proficient in the use of design-build and have successfully implemented design-build programs to be nominated for this award. However, it is not essential that the agency is responsible for a large or long-standing design-build program. Agencies that have provided significant support to the design-build industry while building a new design-build program through encouraged use of DBIA Best Practices are also encouraged to apply.

Who can Nominate: An individual or company may provide the nomination. In addition, owners may nominate themselves for this award. Membership in DBIA is not a requirement for the owner or the nominator. However, membership in DBIA is a plus for either. DBIA does not require an entry fee for this nomination.
