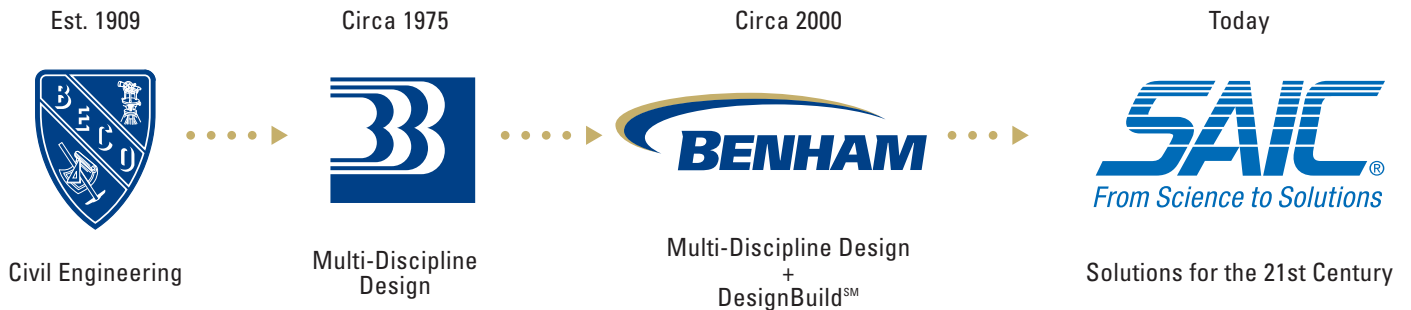


# One Year After Acquisition by SAIC, Benham Leverages Synergies With SAIC to Grow and Expand Services

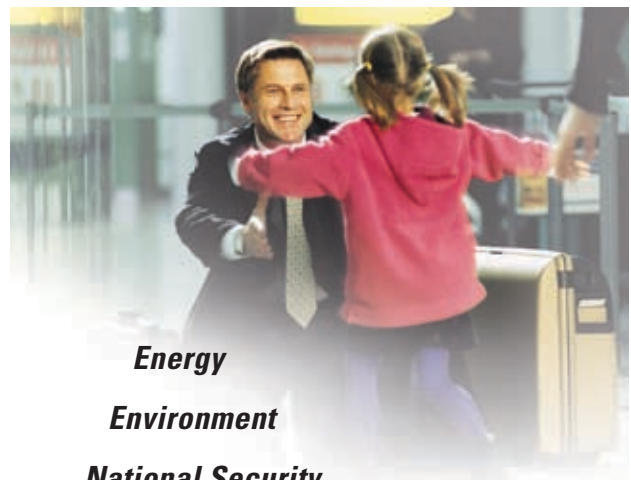
